**Glengarry and District Community Hall Heating System**

Project description

To replace the existing and expensive to run oil heating system within the Glengarry and District Community Hall, with an environmentally friendly and more economic system. The solution was to install a ground source heat pump system and apply for the RHI grant on completion (Renewable Heat Incentive).

Anticipated results

The system was installed successfully and commissioned, allowing the RHI grant to be claimed. We feel that the project was innovative in its outcome because the running costs of the heating system are now self-funding and even give a little extra to cover some of the other electricity costs incurred by the running of the hall. Thus the heating system is therefore giving a long term benefit to the community by providing heating in the hall at a minimal cost and is improving the sustainability of the community hall.
