HOW TO APPLY

- Applicants must be **16 or over** at the start of the course.
- Eligible applicants are those individuals living nearby Falck Renewables Wind Farms **Åliden and Brattmyrliden** located nearby Trehörningsjö and Byviken.
- Applicants must be studying a **qualification** that would help them gain professional skills they can use in the **renewable/sustainable energy sector**.
- All applicants must complete the online application form, including details of an **academic referee** who is willing to support the application.
- The annual fund of **SEK 60000** will be shared between the successful applicants.
- Falck Renewables may decide to **provide a portion** of the support applied for.
- Falck Renewables will cover expenses which assist the candidates to complete their course. Eligible expenses include **travel/commuting costs, training materials (books, software), internet connection and equipment**.
- The successful applicant must provide **receipts or evidence** of all their expenditure.
- **Evidence** that the applicant is registered and attending the course will be required before any money is paid.
- Applicants may be asked to **repay funds** if they fail to complete the course.
- Applications will be considered by a Falck Renewables' **committee** made up of Scott Gilbert, General Manager Nordics, Salomé San Miguel, Country Manager Sweden, Alessandro Costa, Head of Sustainability.
